

Young Talents Competition May 23rd -24th, 2020

Parma (PR) - Italy

Art. 1 Competition enrollment

The competition is open to all musicians of all nationalities and will be taking place at "Casa della Musica" - P.le San Francesco, 1 - Parma (Italy) on May 23rd-24th, 2020

Art. 2 Sections and categories

All rounds will be open to the public. Sections and categories will be arranged as following:

• Secondary school of first grade (solo selection, guitar)

A Category: first year class B Category: second year class C Category: third year class

• Solo selection (Guitar)

D Category: born from 2008 E Category: born from 2004 to 2007 F Category: born from 2000 to 2003

• Chamber music selection:

G Category: groups from 2 to 4 musicians with at least one guitar (average age under 18) H Category: Secondary school of first grade guitar ensembles from 5 to 25 musicians I Category: Secondary school of first grade guitar ensembles from 5 to 25 musicians

In the solo selection D-E-F categories participants are allowed to enter a higher age category.

In H and I categories, apart from the guitar players, only two other players with different instruments will be allowed in each ensemble.

Neither the outright winners of a previous edition in solo selection nor winning groups in the chamber music selection can enroll with the same ensemble or for the same category.

It's not possible to apply for both Young Talents and International Competition

Art. 3 Registration fees

• Secondary school of first grade (solo selection, guitar): A, B, C Category: € 20

- Solo selection (Guitar) D, E, F Category: € 30
- Chamber music selection, G-H-I Category: € 20 for each member

Art. 4 The Jury

The Jury consist of conservatory professors, music schools teachers and preeminent musicians

Art. 5 Programs

• Secondary school of first grade (solo selection, guitar), in one round*:

A Category: free program - maximum duration: 4 minutes

B Category: free program - maximum duration: 6 minutes

C Category: free program - maximum duration: 8 minutes

• Solo selection, in one round*:

B Category: free program - maximum duration: 6 minutes

C Category: free program - maximum duration: 8 minutes

D Category: free program - maximum duration: 10 minutes (with at least one Ghiribizzo by N.Paganini, from "43 Ghiribizzi" M.S.43)

• Chamber music selection*:

G-H-I Category: free program: maximum duration 8 minutes

* Only as free program transcriptions will be admitted.

Art. 6 Scores

The point system is expressed in cents. Participants with a score not less than 95/100 will be assigned the 1st prize. Participants with a score not less than 90/100 will be assigned the 2nd prize. Participants with a score not less than 85/100 will be assigned the 3rd prize. The outright winner for each section will be the participant with the highest score within first prizes. The decision of the Jury is not subject to appeal. Results will be announced at the end of each category late morning and late afternoon.

The award giving ceremony for D-E-F-G-H-I categories will take place on Saturday May 23rd, 2020 starting from 6.45 p.m. at Auditorium Casa della Musica in Parma (PR).

The award giving ceremony for A-B-C categories will take place on Sunday May 24th, 2020 starting from 2.30 p.m. at the Auditorium Casa della Musica in Parma (PR)

Prize winners must be present at the ceremony: failing to do so will result in the loss of the prize

Art. 8 Auditions

Prior to the audition all participants will have to submit to the Jury a copy of the scores of their program and an ID card or passport. The auditions' schedule, the time and the location of the roll call will be on-line starting from May 15th, 2020. Late-coming competitors may be admitted according to the final decision of the Jury before the drawing up of their category's minutes has been completed. The Jury is allowed to stop the performance in case it will exceed the time limit. Those members of the Jury who have family relationship or ongoing teaching relationships with participants must declare it and will be abstained from judging them.
